



1. PERFORMANCE

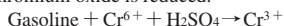
- 1) Measuring range : 0.05-0.6 %
- Number of pump strokes : 1 (100mℓ)
- (This detector tube is calibrated by Hexane.)
- 2) Sampling time : 1 minute / 1 pump stroke
- 3) Detectable limit : 0.005 % (50 ppm)
- 4) Shelf life : 3 years
- 5) Operating temperature : 10 ~ 40 °C
- 6) Temperature compensation : Necessary (See "TEMPERATURE CORRECTION TABLE")
- 7) Reading : Direct reading from the scale calibrated by 1 pump stroke
- 8) Colour change : Orange → Dark green

Chromium oxide is reduced.



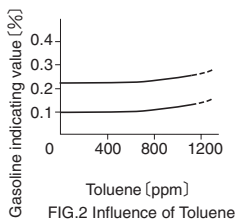
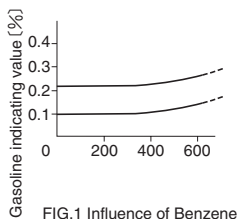

In presence of Alcohols, Ketones or Esters less than 6 %, the accuracy of readings is not affected.
